WHEREAS, chemical dependency is a treatable disease and the treatment of addiction can be as successful as the treatment of other chronic diseases; and


WHEREAS, addictions counselors are uniquely qualified frontline healthcare professionals who are indispensable in the process of guiding patients with addictive disorders to recovery; and
