Description/Significant Features:

Wooden frame structure with gabled roofline that currently has a lateral orientation; shed-roofed porch spans the western elevation and wraps around to the south elevation, where it is integrated beneath the main gabled roof; it is supported by square columns. The front elevation has three bays: entry door and two windows; south elevation, has a double entry door and single six-over-six, double-hung, vinyl sash window; east elevation has enclosed secondary entry porch.

Enclosure of side porch; possible re-orientation of front elevation - mid-twentieth century
replacement windows - late twentieth century
