SUMMARY REPORT

Meeting of Commission on Higher Education, June 5, 1986

1987-88 APPROPRIATION FORMULA

The Commission approved changes in the appropriation formula for 1987-88, including Formula for Academic Institutions, Formula for Teaching Hospital, and Formula for Area Health Education Centers (AHEC).

BUDGET FOR TEACHER LOAN PROGRAM

The Education Improvement Act (EIA) of 1984 authorized the establishment of the Teacher Loan Program, to be administered by the South Carolina Student Loan Corporation. The EIA provided that appropriations for loans and administrative costs are recommended by the Commission on Higher Education. The Commission approved operating expenditures of \$93,115 for 1986-87 for administration of the program.

ANNUAL PERMANENT IMPROVEMENT PLANS

The Commission approved the following annual permanent improvement plans of the colleges and universities for 1986-87: The Citadel, 4 projects totaling \$950,000; Clemson University, 19 projects totaling \$4,115,000; College of Charleston, 14 projects totaling \$1,080,000; Francis Marion College, 5 projects totaling \$300,000; Medical University of South Carolina, 17 projects totaling \$11,780,000; USC-Coastal Carolina, 4 projects totaling \$694,550; and University of South Carolina-Columbia, 21 projects totaling \$2,754,551.

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

The Commission approved a request by the Medical University of South Carolina to lease a 4.35 acre site at Cannon Street and Courtney Drive, Charleston, to the National Medical Enterprises, Inc. (NME) for a Geriatric Center and a Rehabilitation Center.

INFORMATIONAL REPORT

A Technical Assistance Workshop for institutional personnel who assist with the implementation of the State Higher Education Desegregation Plan will be held in Columbia on June 12, 1986.
