In June we had a merits hearing and in this hearing the judge told DSS that no later than 60 days he wants to have a hearing to terminate the parents rights (TPR). We are now in the month of December and we aren't even on the docket. I have wrote letters, tried to have a meeting with the director, Mr. Palmer and he or his secretary won't call or email me back. Today I had a meeting with the DSS lawyer, Ms. McIntee who falsely told me we had a 15 December court date for TPR. Sir, I really have no where else to turn for help except you. DSS is out of control in your state. It took Ava's sister, Nora two years for her adoption to! go thru. I don't want this for Ava, we are all she knows her mother has four children in the system and has only seen Ava once when she was 14 days old and she was high. Please help us out, I beg this of you.
