SECTION 1: The Minutes for the meeting of April 17, 2003; copies of which had been previously mailed to each member of the Commission, were approved.

SECTION 2: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the request of the Department to advertise and select the services for partnering facilitators, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 3: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the request of the Department for professional engineering services for several bridges in various counties as well as design-build support for the Carolina Bays Parkway, Phase II Project, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 4: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the request of the Department to advertise, select and negotiate with a consulting engineering firm experienced in ferry design operation, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 5: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the request of the Department to select and negotiate with firms to provide surveying services on a statewide "on call" basis, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 6: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in extending an existing bituminous retreatment contract to include additional resurfacing work, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 12: On motion of Commissioner Stoddard, seconded by Commissioner Mack, the Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the request of the Town of Cowpens to name Highway 110 from Highway 29 to the town limits as the "Bertha Smith Boulevard".

SECTION 13: On motion of Commissioner Hardee, seconded by Commissioner Mack, the Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the 2003/2004 STIP funding plan, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

**REQUEST FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR PARTNERING
FACILITATORS**

The Department requests Commission approval to advertise and select individuals or consulting firm(s) for the purpose of providing in cooperation with the Carolinas AGC, a partnering management technique that has saved many millions of dollars and countless amounts of time on projects across the United States. This project will be funded through the various Federal and State programs.

REQUEST FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR:

SEVERAL BRIDGES IN VARIOUS COUNTIES

Projects 1 – 6 will be funded through the Bridge Replacement program.

- 1] US 378: Bridges over the Black River in Sumter County
- 2] US 76: Bridge over the Chattooga River in Oconee County
- 3] US 1: Bridge over the Great Pee Dee River in Chesterfield/Marlboro Counties
- 4] SC 34: Bridges over the Great Pee Dee River in Darlington/Marlboro Counties
- 5] SC 41: Bridges over the Lynches River in Florence County
- 6] US 601: Bridges over the Congaree River in Calhoun/Richland Counties

The Department has received an additional 21 million for bridge replacements in FY 03 and FY 04 in addition to the current program. These services are needed to allow staff to complete current projects and have projects ready to advance to letting in the upcoming fiscal year to obligate available funds.

FOR DESIGN-BUILD SUPPORT ON THE CAROLINA BAYS PARKWAY PHASE II PROJECT

This project is funded by the State Infrastructure Bank.

The Department requests Commission approval to advertise and select consulting firms for the purpose of providing engineering design services for the replacement of the below bridges and for providing support services on the Carolina Bays Parkway design-build project. Based on current and projected workloads, the Department does not have sufficient staff to provide the on-demand services needed to execute the review of the final design, shop drawings and other items for this design build contract.

Request for Professional Consulting Services

The Department's Bridge Maintenance Office seeks approval to advertise, select, and negotiate with a Consulting Engineering Firm experienced in all phases of Ferry Design and Operation. The Department of Natural Resources has requested that the DOT determine the feasibility of replacing and upgrading the existing Ferry of South Island with a new larger Ferry. DNR in conjunction with Yawkey Foundation will fund this work.

The Department does not have the required training and certifications necessary to perform this type work. Therefore, use of a Consulting engineering Firm is necessary.

Phase I: Feasibility study and preliminary design (approximate cost \$50,000.00)

Phase II: Final design and plan preparation (approximate cost \$200,000.00)

Phase III: Construction inspection (approximate cost \$100,000.00)

Total Estimate Cost: \$350,000.00

"On Call" Professional Surveying Services

The Department requests Commission approval to select and negotiate with firms to provide surveying services on a statewide "on call" basis. These services will be utilized for the Preconstruction field surveying necessary for the development of highway and/or bridge projects when the projected workload exceeds the capabilities of the Department's Preconstruction Survey's Office.

The contract will cover a period of approximately three (3) years. The total estimated cost for the contract is \$ 500,000.00 per year. Funding for these services will be on a project-by-project basis and will be provided from various Federal and State funds.

EXTENSION OF BITUMINOUS RESURFACING CONTRACT

TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL RESURFACING WORK

It is recommended that the Commission approve the action of the Department in extending an existing bituminous retreatment contract to include additional resurfacing work as follows:

Contract of Rea Construction Company - File Nos. 6.101C and 6.1L - extended to include resurfacing (Lead File No. 3.2003) on Road S-589 and L-589 Extension.

Estimated Cost of Extension

\$ 22,514.88

This extension was authorized by the Department prior to formal approval by the Commission since the adjacent work had reached such a stage of completion that the contractor involved could not accept the additional work unless it were authorized without delay.



Mass Transit Funding



 - **2003-2004 Mass Transit Funds**
 - **Daufuskie Island Ferry (\$50,000)**
 - These funds will continue to assist Beaufort County in the operation of its ferry services to and from Daufuskie Island. The SCDOT is working in cooperation with Beaufort County to provide services.
 - **Vanpool (\$30,000)**
 - These funds are recommended to provide needed to the citizens of Sumter that work in the Columbia area.
 - **Virtual Transit Enterprise (VTE) Program (\$224,387)**
 - South Carolina Department of Transportation's three-year initiative to support the state's mass transit providers with shared technology solutions for grant management, and information sharing.
 - **State Administration Match (\$348,058)**
 - These funds will be used to match federal portion of the State Administration.
 - **Special Projects (\$262,555)**
 - These funds will be used to improve coordination and other Mass Transit projects that will include the development of a statewide plan for public transportation.
