## Governor's Proclamation

WHEREAS, founded by a group of Greenville businessmen in 1937 to help people cope with the devastating effects of the Great Depression, Miracle Hill Ministries has grown to be the largest provider of services to the homeless in South Carolina; and

WHEREAS, expanding its ministries to meet the increasing needs of the growing community, Miracle Hill operates rescue missions to provide shelter for the homeless, thrift stores to raise operating funds and provide work-training skills for the men and women in their recovery programs, and a relief ministry to help feed the hungry; and

WHEREAS, to address the increasing demands of children unable to stay in their homes, the Miracle Hill Children's Home serves children in need both on campus and in licensed foster care placements while the Boy's Shelter offers a safe haven for at-risk abused, neglected, and troubled teens; and

WHEREAS, through compassion, adaptation, Christian faith, and grace, the dedicated employees and supporters of Miracle Hill Ministries help individuals and families navigate the path from hopelessness to success.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the Great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim April 26, 2012, as
