



Ms. Prevatte, thank you for you inquiry to info@scdhs.gov. You wrote: "We realize that the managed care orgs are in the business to make a profit. How much of the current shortfall is due to the MCO's? We would appreciate a dollar amount and a %." The current shortfall is not due to Medicaid reimbursement to the MCO's. The shortfall is due to the increased cost of providing coverage to a net increase of over 130,000 people enrolled in Medicaid over the past two years, since the beginning of the recession, combined with three successive years of budget reductions to the Medicaid base budget, and the depletion of Medicaid reserves. The care coordination provided by the MCO's helps to control the cost of providing care to Medicaid enrollees, and the risk adjusted cost per enrollee is less than traditional Medicaid fee for service. For your information, I have attached a copy of a managed care cost savings analysis prepared by Milliman.
