Hi! Sorry to bother you again, in my last email I had stated that my sister was on meth and we were worried about her two small children. To catch you up on things, the kids were taken from my younger sister and given temp custody to my older sister. During these past two weeks we have learned that our 9 month old nephew tested positive for meth. (cut off for his age is 500 and h tested 1500) I'm not sure how the numbers fall into place but maybe you all do or can help me understand that. That being said today we learned my younger sister was to report to the Oconee County Sheriffs Office and speak with Officer Brian Long, he spoke with her and then sent her to Walhalla Police dept. There she was told that she was to report in the am, be locked up for 6-10 hrs and then would be released. Also she was told that if she turned in who she was getting her drugs from, that after 6 days they could make an arrest, her charges would be dropped. This to me is telling me that it is OK with our local police and government agencies for a child to test positive for meth. I need your help and helping me take this to the highest level I can. My nephew didn't have a choice to b exposed therefore its not fair to him the choices his mother made. That she is not going to be held responsible for those choices. I hope you understand why drugs are so bad in this state and especially this county right now. My older sister and myself have worried and stressed over this situation and the things we got accomplished were no use.
