Chairman Donnie Betenbaugh presented for second reading the ordinance authorizing the issuance and sale of General Obligation Bonds, Series 2007, of Union County, South Carolina, in the principal amount of not exceeding \$2,300,000.00; fixing the form and certain details of the bonds; authorizing the County Supervisor to determine certain matters relating to the bonds; providing for the payment of the bonds and the disposition of the proceeds thereof; and other matters relating thereto.

Dora Martin: Made a motion to accept second reading of the ordinance pertaining to the issuance and sale of General Obligation Bonds of Union County as stated.
