Thanks again for taking my call a few days ago. I'm preaching a basic sermon on Gospel-centered citizenship from Titus 2:1-8.

I want to walk through the passage quickly and then use our interview as a way to apply the text to our people.

I will introduce you and invite you to join me up on stage. We will be seated some stools.

Our dialogue will be conversational but these questions will guide the discussion.

1. How do you come to follow Christ?
2. When did you feel your role as a community member would involve public service and why?
