Happy 75th Anniversary Lee State Park! 75 years ago this month, 174 men from Richland, Calhoun, Sumter, Orangeburg, Lancaster, Hampton and Bamberg counties had arrived at Camp Lee as part of Civilian Conservation Corps Company 4471. Their job was to build Lee State Park. They joined 25 men who had arrived in June to build the CCC Camp that the enrollees would live in while building the park. This group of 199 was just the beginning. Over the years 1935 to 1940, many young men called Camp Lee home as part of Company 4471. Their handiwork includes the park entrance gates, artesian wells, a foot bridge and spillway built using local iron sandstone. They also built picnic shelters, ponds and the Loop Road and planted many trees and shrubs. THANK YOU COMPANY 4471 FOR LEE!
