

May 26, 1943.

The Budget Commission met in the Governor's Office at 11:00 o'clock, all members being present.

The following transfers were authorized as to 1942-43 appropriations:

Legislative Department - House of Representatives

From Approved Accounts \$440.29 - To Mileage and Stationery.

S. C. Probation and Parole Board

From Salaries, Steno-File Clerk \$800.00 - To Office Equipment

From Salaries, Steno-File Clerk \$400.00 - To Office Supplies

From Special Payments - Per Diem of Board \$132.00 - To Association Dues.

From Travel \$1,549.84 - To Probation Officers and Case Supervisor.

State Board of Fisheries

From Travel \$300.00 - To Office Supplies.

The following transfers were authorized as to 1943-44 appropriations:

State Planning Board

From Salaries - Senior Technician \$2,220.00 - To Special Payments - Consultants and Technicians.

From Special Payments - Stenographic Services \$240.00 - To Salaries - Stenographer-Clerk.

The following allotment was made from the 1942-43 Civil Contingent

Fund:

Governor's Office, Law Enforcement, \$300.00 for Insurance.

Action on the request of Clemson College for transfer of \$50,000.00, appropriated for the fiscal year 1942-43 for the Construction of an Armory, so as to be allowed to use the amount for repairs and renovations at Clemson College, was deferred until a subsequent meeting.

The Commission further deferred consideration of the request of the Tax Commission for \$4,000.00 from the Civil Contingent Fund, to provide salary for Mr. P. M. Minus.
