- WHEREAS,** consumers of prescription and nonprescription medications, or their caregivers, should be knowledgeable about and share responsibility for their own drug therapy; and
- WHEREAS,** with their education, focus, and level of expertise, pharmacists are ideally suited to work collaboratively with patients and other health care providers to improve medication use and outcomes by providing services through medication therapy management; and
- WHEREAS,** the 2014 observance of Pharmacists Month helps raise awareness of the important role pharmacists play in the safe use of medication.
