#### Description/Significant Features:

Inland swamp rice field on Hagget Hall Plantation in Newton Creek drainage. Creek is in Ashley River watershed. Remains of dams, facing ditches and banks, causeways, canals. Dams have an 8-10 base and are 2-4 foot above grade, perpendicular to water flow. They have corresponding ditches that are 1-3 feet below grade. Facing banks similar in size but are parallel to water flow and also have corresponding ditches.

## **Historical Information**

Historical Information:

Remains located in Newton Creek drainage inside eastern Watson Hill Tract. Features are associated with Haggott Hall Plantation, sometimes called "Hackett Hall." Features located inside the flood plain of freshwater inland creek typical of the earliest rice planting in SC. Features located along a southeast-northwest axis in the creek bed.
