Chairman Tolly called the meeting to order and Mr. Tom Martin gave the invocation.

Chairman Tolly explained that the reason for the meeting was to set the tax millage for the coming year. The following information was presented: The estimated value of 1 mill (abated) - \$290,380 and the value of 1 mill (unabated) \$335,500.

Mr. Smoak said that to meet the budget for the 1994-1995 fiscal year the County needed 68.6 mills.


