SC State Parks has been working for several years to create and maintain appropriate Longleaf pine habitat at Aiken State Park with the goal of establishing a new population of federally endangered Red-Cockaded Woodpeckers. Last week we successfully translocated 4 individuals (2 males and 2 females) from Francis Marion National Forest with the help of our partners at the Longleaf Alliance, SCDNR and US Forest Service. Birds were safely and successfully captured from their roost trees in the National Forest by federally permitted biologists and placed into their new homes at Aiken State Park the same night. SC State Parks is committed to the management of our new Red-Cockaded Woodpecker population at Aiken State Park, as well as existing populations at Cheraw State Park and Hampton Plantation State Historic Site. www.SouthCarolinaParks.com
