Subject: Try GeoMaps -- a new way to visualize our data

Dear Colleague:

Social Security provides financial benefits, tools, and information to help support you throughout life's journey. We are pleased to announce the launch of geospatial mapping at Social Security! Our new initiative, *GeoMaps*, complements our existing Open Data and Open Data initiatives.

For several years, we have published a wealth of data on Data.gov concerning subjects as varied as Social Security Number Verification Service we offer for employers. We know people learn and receive information from maps. GeoMaps is an interactive mapping tool that lets you view large amounts of our data in a quick, geographically relevant way. You can also download the data, and mesh it with your own data to create other maps.

We've started with these maps and plan to add more in the future:

- Old Age, Survivors, and Disability Insurance benefits by state; and
- "Help America Vote Verification System" transactions by state. Social Security manages this system for verifying the information of newly registered voters for federal elections.
