SUMMARY REPORT

Meeting of Commission on Higher Education, December 1, 1983

The Commission approved two documents for publication, the Review of the South Carolina Master Plan for Higher Education and the "Summary" of the Review, and recommended that the "Summary" be distributed widely.

The Commission received as information a report on recent activities of the Joint Health and Medical Education Board.

Commission members met with the Council of Presidents of Public Colleges and Universities at a luncheon meeting, held at the University of South Carolina.

The Commission presented a Resolution to Mr. James L. Solomon, Jr., who recently was named Commissioner of the South Carolina Department of Social Services. Mr. Solomon served as the Commission's Assistant Director for Facilities and Planning (1982-83) and Coordinator of Facilities Planning (1974-82), and as Executive Director of the South Carolina Higher Education Facilities Commission (1973-74).

Special Meeting of Commission, December 15, 1983

At a special meeting on December 15, 1983, the Commission adopted an additional position paper on the "Improvement of Educational Opportunity in South Carolina." This paper stresses the importance of adequate funding for all of public education, including the postsecondary components, as was also the case in the position paper adopted by the Commission on November 3, 1983. The Commission also indicated its support of the educational programs in the "New Approach to Quality Education" developed by two blue-ribbon committees and publicly presented by the Governor.
