Visit with students and teachers

The primary purpose of the school visit will be to understand security issues and get feedback from teachers.

4:00-4:10 PM Walking tour the maximum security lock-up

The December security incident where boys set a fire and escaped occurred in lock-up.

4:15-4:30 PM Visit the Magnolia Dorm (Girls)

The 5 girls who were in the Transition home when the boys broke in Friday before last have been relocated to Magnolia Dorm.

4:30-4:45 PM Visit Poplar Dorm (Boys)

This dorm is currently being used as a step-down unit, but the configuration and design is the same as other dorms and will give you a sense of the security issues present in the new generation of DJJ dorms.

4:45-5:00 PM Visit the Girls Transition House

The Transition house was where the girls were assaulted in the recent incident. The boys set a fire in Cypress dorm, and after being evacuated, they ran to the Girls Transition house, where they broke windows to get inside.
