Here at Turbeville Prison, there have been a few scandals involving staff- stealing funds, yet they still work here.

And we have (1) vocational trade here now, Carpentry. Which if you not a Youthful Offender, you cannot get in. The Federal Gov. gives Sc. \$500<sup>00</sup> for each youthful offender enrolled. Even if he does nothing but draw or Rap all day like they did in the Electrical Class I taught. Many of us straight times would like to learn a trade. I'm a Chef by trade. I would be willing to give 1/2 of any monies I would make to a homeless center in my area. I have tried to get to Tyger River CI, to work Prison Industries.

They pay minimum wage. If you can help me get there to start work. I'd be happy to give back 1/2 to the community.

I meet all requirements.

Again, Thanks for all you have done, too bad you can't go another 8 years.
