I wanted to make sure you saw what the governor posted on her Facebook about the unemployment rate dropping so you could include it in your story.

South Carolina is on the move, our unemployment rate dropped to 5.1 percent! Down for the fourth month in a row! We continue to set economic development records across the state - more people working than ever before in state history, 80,572 jobs announced in 45 of 46 counties and our lowest unemployment rate in over a decade - but we can do more: we are going to stay focused on workforce development, continue to strengthen our schools, and reform DOT so we can invest in a statewide roads plan.
