I would like to start by thanking you for the great job you do for our State. I know you're a busy person and have a lot of issues to deal with that your job require. I'm writing concerning the latest change in the Department of Corrections. I'm currently incarcerated at the Walolen Correctional Institution. I'm currently serving a 14 yrs sentence for Distribution of Cocaine Base. I was sentenced on Mar. 8, 07 in Marion County S.C., in which this is a nonviolent offense but I'm serving 85% of my sentence which 11 yrs & months to max out. I don't have a parole eligible offense in which was given to offenders after June 10, 2010 in which have same charge. Now as of March 2016 those offenders now are serving 65% and 51% for good behavior and work credits. This retroactive action only included offenders after June 10, 2010 which leaves offenders such and like me in same situation no parole and sentenced as same as violent offenders.

This meaning that by us being incarcerated before the offenders that receive relief that our crimes are different. I dont know if this is how the justice system works on our state, There is no access to the law library at this institution I work at the Criminal Justice Academy for past 4 yrs. I have been a moderate inmate and have rehabilitated myself. I know and understand you're a busy person and have a lot to get done. I just would really appreciate a response if nothing else I just pray for relief.
