**Subject:** SCDOT Secretary Hall's Storm Recovery Update

Secretary Hall's Storm Recovery Report and the Road Closure Report are attached.

- State road closures are down from a peak of 541 (Oct. 5) to 73 (Nov. 17), an 87 percent decrease.
- SCDOT Maintenance forces have led the majority of the repairs, including initiating 3 bridge replacement projects with in-house forces.
- 24 highway/bridge contractors have been engaged to assist with 69 different "emergency/spot repairs" in 16 counties.
- Contractors have also been engaged on 10 bridge replacement or major bridge/culvert repair projects in 4 counties.
- Debris collected to date: approx. 1,829 loads (88,510 cubic yards)
- 13 of the remaining 73 road closures are expected to be re-opened by Thanksgiving.
- 8 primary routes remain closed statewide.
