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**Subject:** Ventura County, Calif., launches Network of Care innovation for foster care

At the recent NACo conference, we saw a presentation of a wonderful new innovation in Foster Care piloted here in Ventura County, Calif. **The Network of Care for Foster Care** consists of a community-based Web portal with all available services; support; medical and social information; advocacy, and much more.

The Network of Care also contains a highly advanced Personal Health Record for foster youth that, for the first time, *integrates health data from multiple agencies* – such as mental health; social services; Medicaid; schools, and the like. It does this with complete confidentiality and control by the county. This breakthrough is extremely helpful to foster parents and agency case managers alike. The Network of Care easily can be replicated to any county in the country.
