

All Housing Space Filled At Gonzales

W. S. Hendley, Sr., chairman of the Columbia Housing authority, yesterday wired Nathan Straus, head of the federal housing commission, that the new low-cost Gonzales Gardens housing project here was 100 per cent. leased.

There are 236 families which have leased quarters in the attractive new project. The families total 1,000 individuals.

By October 1, it was learned yesterday from William Geddings, supervising manager, the families will all have taken up their leased apartments. Nearly all families have already moved there and established homes.

Others desiring to obtain apartments have been asked to call at the administration offices, Gonzales Gardens, and file application. It is desired to fill from a waiting list all vacancies which occur.
