M I N U T E S

Mr. Poore called the meeting to order and Councilman Fred H. Bratcher gave the invocation.

On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Kinley, Council voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the March 3, 1981 meeting as mailed.

Mr. Tom Burnett with Southern Bell Telephone Company presented a proposal for a Dimenion 400 telephone system to be located in the Bailes Building for all County offices. Council seen a film and heard the advantages of the System. He explained an alternative to the existing system. Council received as information.

Mr. James Campbell explained to Council that funds were no longer available for CETA employees now under Title VI and IID. There would be 23 participants terminated March 31, 1981 under Title VI and 31 participants to be terminated April 3, 1981 under Title II-D. Council received as information.

Mr. Jimmy Elrod asked Council to consider some solution to the existing dog problem that the County is now having. Mr. Poore advised the County Attorney to check with other Counties and see what solution he could come up with. Council received as information.

Mr. Clinton King, Director of Anderson County Solid Waste Management Authority, requested \$52,302 supplementary funds for the remainder of the 1980-81 fiscal year. He stated that his request was due to the tremendous increase in fuel and oil and the loss of two (2) CETA employees that were needed to clean the landfill. Mr. Poore stated that he could let Mr. King use two of his AA trustees. Council received as information.

Mr. David Crenshaw came before Council asking for an additional appropriation to his 1980-81 fiscal year budget in the amount of \$68,750 which would take care of the Jail and Sheriff's Department for the balance of this fiscal year. Council received as information.

Mr. David Watson presented sealed bids for asphalt for April 1, 1981 until June 30, 1981. He stated that the bids were \$24.65 and \$24.75 per ton, but the high bidder had agreed to meet the low bid price because of the location of the plants. On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Bratcher, Council voted unanimously to split the business with Tribble and Pickens Construction Companies as done in the past.

Mr. Robert P. Lusk read an Assistance Agreement for Orian Rugs to allow for the issuance of Industrial Revenue Bonds to expand their plant on Highway 81. On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Kinley, Council voted unanimously to approve the Assistance Agreement.

Mr. Lusk presented Ordinance #63 (\$3 Million General Obligation Bonds) for renovations of the Bailes Building and Courthouse. On the motion of Mr. Wright, seconded by Mr. Hooper, Council voted unanimously to adopt on first reading Ordinance #63.

On the motion of Mr. Kinley, seconded by Mr. Hooper, Council adjourned at 8:35 p.m.
