Winter Ag Tour to be held in Caribbean

The S.C. Department of Agriculture is taking its ag tour from the Midwest to the Caribbean.

In August, 34 ag study participants visited sites in Kansas and Nebraska. In January, our Winter Agricultural Study Tour will be in Puerto Rico, where South Carolinians will visit ag and historical sites throughout the island.

Each year the S.C. Department of Agriculture holds ag study tours to various spots in the United States and around the world. The purpose is to let farmers, agribusiness professionals and anyone interested in agriculture witness farming practices in other parts of the world. After each trip, people who participate come back home with a wealth of information, much of which they can use on their own farms or in their own businesses.

"These trips are a fun, highly educational experience for anyone with an interest in agriculture," said Roy Copelan, marketing specialist for the SCDA. "It's not something you'd want to miss."

Joe Oswald Jr., a now-disabled former farmer of JCO Farms in Allendale, has been on many of these trips, and said each is filled with interesting tours and agricultural information. He took his wife Janie and his 8-year-old grandson Joe IV on the Department's most recent trip to Kansas and Nebraska last month. They visited farms throughout the region, the world's largest grain elevator,

dairies, an ethanol plant and literally scores of other places.

"We had long, event-filled days and short nights," Oswald said. "It was very worthwhile."

The 73-year-old also said he'd like to go on future trips.

The ag tour to Puerto Rico was announced in July and will be held Jan. 26-Feb. 2, 2000. The eight-day tour—like all the ag tours—will include visits to spots that relate to all aspects of agriculture and agribusiness opportunities. Those aspects will include food processing, livestock operations, field crops, fruits and vegetables and tourist attractions. Some highlights include visits to a plantain operation, Procesador Campfresco Pineapple (formerly Lotus), a tomato/vegetable operation, The Firehouse (for a little culture), a castle, an Indian ceremonial center, a fruit experiment farm at the College of Agriculture, Bayamon Tobacco and much, much more.

Early bird cost for the trip—for those who sign up by Oct. 14—is \$2150 per person or \$4125 per couple. After Oct. 14, the cost will be \$2400 per person or \$4600 per couple. The cost is tax-deductible. Space is limited, so Copelan advises those who are interested to act now. For more information or to register, call Copelan at (803) 734-2210.

Commissioner's Column

S.C. group gives lessons in horse-and-buggy driving

In Edgefield County, David Snodgrass and Joe Clapp are working hard to give people with special needs the chance to learn a fading art.

The two have teamed up to teach the physically challenged how to drive a horse and buggy—an experiment they hope will be both therapeutic and entertaining for their students.

Joe, who has a 17-year-old daughter born with cerebral palsy and a wife who lost both legs to diabetes complications, said he'd searched for fun activities for his wife and daughter, but that his options were limited. He had heard of therapeutic horseback riding lessons given in different parts of the state, but children and adults with severe disabilities are unable to horseback ride alone. So Joe suggested a more inclusive sport that could accommodate more people. David agreed to donate his resources, and the two formed a committee for the establishment of the Broken Wing Driving Club Inc. to train students to drive horse-drawn buggies.

"We just decided this was something we could do to try to help them," Joe said.

That was about a year ago. Since then, David and Joe have been working hard to get their good-natured operation off the ground, building barns, raising money and searching for more horses and buggies to accommodate the students they hope to enroll.

David, Joe and other volunteers have already begun training some students, even as they are establishing themselves as an organization and collecting money. The cost to give one student driving lessons is \$100, but the students are not charged. Instead, their lessons are funded by donations. That means they need help from

the community to keep the operation going, and I am eager to see David's property teaming with students.

"We are looking to be a nonprofit organization so that anyone who donates to us can use it as a tax write-off," Joe said.

The driving club is a good cause to which to donate. Our fast-paced society too often restricts those with special needs, and I applaud any attempt to remove those restrictions—especially when it involves agriculture.

It's important to realize that the fledgling group needs more than just monetary donations—they need your time. If you live close by, I urge you to become a volunteer to either teach classes or help with other necessary duties. It's a great way for horse lovers to help others while teaching something they enjoy. For those of you who live too far away to volunteer, the club is always looking for supplies, including riding gear, feed and, of course, horses. The club is located near the Trenton Airport and currently operates only on the weekends.

Students can learn a variety of things at the Broken Wing Driving Club. They can start off slowly by learning how to care for a horse, and graduate to driving their own buggies. They even have buggies that are equipped to hold wheelchairs, which give the students more freedom to drive them without assistance. One goal Joe has for his students is to teach them enough about driving to enter the South Carolina State Fair, which will be held Oct. 7-17 at the State Fairgrounds off Bluff Road in Columbia.

"We want them to learn enough to go to the fair so they can tell people, 'I competed in the State Fair,'" Joe said.

Anyone 8 years old or older can participate in the program, and children without special needs can participate as well for a fee—if class space is available. Sweet Potato/Apple Bake

Ingredients: Filling — 2 lbs. fresh S.C. sweet potatoes, 1 1/2 lbs. S.C. cooking apples, 2/3 cup light brown sugar, 6 tablespoons margarine, 1/2 cup apple cider, 3 tablespoons maple syrup, 1 tablespoon lemon juice, 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon, 1/2 teaspoon ground ginger.

Directions: Boil potatoes, cool, skin and slice 1/4 inch thick. Peel apples, quarter, core and slice 1/4 inch thick. While combining other ingredients, keep apples in fruit juice to prevent discoloration. In a small saucepan, bring sugar, margarine, cider, syrup, lemon juice, cinnamon and ginger to a boil. Reduce heat and cook mixture for 10 minutes, stirring constantly. Drain apples well and pat dry. Arrange apples and sweet potatoes in a 9x13x2 inch casserole dish. Cover with sauce. Bake at 325°F for 25-30 minutes, basting occasionally. Makes 6 servings.
