Our office received your Freedom of Information Act request for the following:

Our office will provide any and all records in our possession that are responsive to your request, subject to any exemptions or redactions as allowed pursuant to Section 30-4-40(a) of the South Carolina Code of Laws or as is otherwise exempt from disclosure by statute or regulation or prohibited from disclosure by court order.

With regard to records from January 2011 to the present, our office has identified records responsive to your request and have determined that those records are exempt from disclosure pursuant to Section 30-4-40(a)(7) (correspondence or work products of legal counsel for a public body and any other material that would violate attorney-client relationships may be exempt from disclosure).

With regard to records prior to January 2011, responsive records may be available from previous gubernatorial administrations, which may be in the possession of the South Carolina Department of Archives and can be contacted at the following address:
