“Ms. June Miller. Ms. Miller was the Clerk of Court for Union County for over 20 years. She retired in 2004. After I became Clerk in 2009, she came back to work for me part time and conducted my bank reconciliations. She retired again this past year.

Ms. Miller agreed to come back and fill in as the Clerk of Court for the remainder of the term. And believe me she has no intentions of running for the office again. I also talked with the staff at the Clerk of Court's office and they are all in agreement that she would be a great choice.

I talked with Rep. Anthony yesterday and he also believes Ms. Miller is a great choice.

If you need any independent references I would suggest Judge John C. Hayes, Chief Administrative Judge for the 16th Circuit, Chief Justice Jean Toal and Justice Costa Pleicones. I have not talked to either of these about Ms. Miller, but all three know her and are very familiar with her work in the office.”
