

SUBJECT: Request for Satellite/Radio Telephone Information

As all of you are aware, the General Assembly requested that the Legislative Audit Council (LAC) conduct an audit of all state agencies' use of cell phones and other wireless communications devices. As part of this audit, the LAC reviewed whether agencies had policies and procedures in place to ensure state-issued cell phones and other devices were used in an efficient manner and whether adequate internal controls were in place to monitor their use.

Based on the results of their review, the LAC made several recommendations for state agencies with regard to satellite telephone/radios with one being that the South Carolina Emergency Management Division (SCEMD) compile and maintain a directory of all satellite telephone numbers. The other was that state agencies "with a satellite phone should establish written policies regarding appropriate reasons for satellite phone acquisition, intended use, management, and testing schedule." The SCEMD is in the process of updating its satellite radio and telephone directory. In order to comply with the LAC recommendation, we are requesting that your agency provide the following information by completing the attached information sheet. Additionally, a comprehensive satellite telephone/radio listing for the state will ensure that all state agencies can be contacted during emergencies. These satellite telephone numbers will only be used after all other communications systems have failed.

After the initial directory has been compiled, all agencies will be asked to notify SCEMD of any equipment changes, telephone number changes, and provide an annual update. This directory will not be distributed to anyone and will be maintained at the State Emergency Operations Center for use and reference during emergencies. Please provide this information by August 20, 2008
