

SECTION 1: The Minutes of the meeting of February 15, 1990; copies of which have been previously mailed to each member of the Commission, were approved.

SECTION 2: The Minutes of the meeting of February 21, 1990; copies of which have been previously mailed to each member of the Commission, were approved.

SECTION 3: The Commission unanimously passed a motion accepting monthly reports as published by the Department of activities of the month of February, 1990.

SECTION 4: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving purchase orders issued for amounts in excess of \$1,000.00 during the month of February, 1990, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 5: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into an agreement with Mr. James A. Scherocman, consulting engineer, to conduct an investigation into the establishment of a program which would provide for contractor quality control of bituminous paving mixtures and acceptance of completed asphalt pavements on the basis of end result specifications, at a cost of \$40,175.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 6: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into an agreement with the developer to exchange the right of way surrounding the Fernandina Road cul-de-sac in return for the necessary right of way to construct the frontage road relocation between Fernandina Road and Woodcross Drive, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 7: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into a supplemental agreement involving a \$12,500 increase in allocation for the Lower Savannah Council of Governments to develop an implementation plan for private sector involvement in a new public transportation system in Aiken County, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 8: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into an agreement with South Carolina State College for providing services for an Entrepreneurial Development Institute Program for 1990, at a cost of \$37,517 and funded by the Federal Highway Administration, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 9: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the transfer of \$200,000.00 from the Headquarters Building Capital Improvement budget to the Headquarters Modular Equipment budget for modular workstation system installations, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 10: The Commission unanimously passed a motion cancelling and transferring allocation of \$453,669.60 State Highway funds for capital improvements/land and buildings, as follows:

The cost of the project is \$37,517 and is to be funded by the Federal Highway Administration.
