WHEREAS, recognizing the importance of movement and an active lifestyle to an individual's health and quality of life, physical therapists work with patients and clients at all levels of ability to restore, maintain, and expand their motion.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim October 2015 as
