Sure -

Past few budgets:

\* FY 2015-16 Executive Budget proposal for \$3,034,694 for mental health staffing and \$927,807 for general medical staff, and \$1,499,659 for facilities upgrades to address inmates with mental health needs.

\* FY 2016-17 Executive Budget \$2,751,818 for mental health staffing, \$722,328 for general medical staff, and \$1,246,340 to staff a male crisis intervention unit.

I think that it's worth noting - Bryan may have something on this - that this isn't a ton of money in the context of the larger budget and further evidence that the training and cultural reforms the Director has made really made the difference, not just the resources.
