National Quality Forum To Hold Meeting To Develop Quality Framework for Community-Based Services

Public Input Sought

The National Quality Forum will hold the first meeting of their Home and Community-Based Services Quality Committee on April 29th and 30th in Washington D.C. The Committee is charged with developing the first draft of a conceptual framework for measuring quality in the delivery of home and community-based services. This is the latest in a continuing series of opportunities to engage stakeholders in the development process. The project will continue well into 2016 and will release a series of draft recommendations for public input beginning in July of 2015.
