"We're doing what we can within our means," she said. "But at the same time we have to look at there is insurance for a reason."

"What we want to do is get people back on their feet," she said.

"What I'm going to ask of the General Assembly is to join me and include that in our own state budget and pay that ourselves," said Governor Haley.

According to the Governor, the state will be able to cover the cost due to \$1.2 billion in additional revenue expected this year. "What we want to do is do South Carolinas part, " explained Governor Haley. "Which is we see what we are able to do, we don't want to put any other states on the hook anymore than we have to. We are more than happy to take care of our share and that's what we'll do."
