WHEREAS, this marks the first time a Big South Conference team has won a national championship and the first time since 1956 that a team has won the championship in their inaugural appearance at the College World Series; and

WHEREAS, with grit, determination, and talent, the Chanticleers demonstrated their expertise on the field, besting the nation with 55 wins, the winningest pitcher, and most home runs; and

WHEREAS, Coach Gary Gilmore, his coaching staff, and the Chanticleer baseball team have worked tirelessly to achieve their sport's highest honor; and

WHEREAS, Coastal's coaches, players, and fans have garnered positive attention for the Palmetto State, conducting themselves with dignity, humility, integrity, and good sportsmanship during the longest College World Series in history.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim July 1, 2016, as
