Gail,

I think it is safe to summarize the current state of the law as follows: if the vehicle is

1. is certified by the manufacturer as being road-worthy, AND
2. if it meets all equipment requirements in South Carolina law (such as Code Section 56-5-4520, which requires that tail lamps must be located at a height of not less than twenty inches from the ground when the vehicle is sitting level, and 56-5-4990, which requires rear-view mirrors),

then we must register it.

Pat and I will work on a comprehensive opinion.
