2015 Major Flood Report Statewide Operations

(10:00 AM- REPORT)
October 25, 2015

Statewide Summary – SCDOT Operations opened 6 more roads since this time yesterday. Seven (7) day a week and 12 hour shifts continue in recovery areas. There are now 54 roads and bridges under contract for repairs.

SCDOT (construction group) and FHWA damage assessment teams continue to work to manage and expedite ongoing contract repairs in accordance to FEMA requirements.

Fifteen (15) counties have been assigned a SCDOT debris removal contractor. The counties where contractors are working today are:

- Richland

Drivers are required to use extreme caution in areas where crews are working.
