
Dear Mr. House:

Thank you for writing our agency regarding information on South Carolina programs that can assist you following the completion of your incarceration.

The Department of Health and Human Services administers the Medicaid program that provides health insurance coverage for low-income families and aged, blind or disabled residents of South Carolina. Medicaid eligibility is based on federal and state financial and categorical guidelines. A Medicaid eligibility worker can determine if you qualify based on the information provided on an application if you decide to apply. If you have access to the Internet, you may want to visit our website at www.scdhhs.gov or call our Medicaid Resource Center (toll-free) at 1-888-549-0820, 8 AM – 6 PM, Monday through Friday, for additional information.

We have enclosed an overview of the Medicaid program as well as information on other programs and organizations that can assist residents in South Carolina with their healthcare needs, prescriptions and daily living expenses. We have also included a list of state agencies that may be of some assistance to you. We hope this information is helpful.
