MINUTES OF BUDGET AND CONTROL BOARD MEETING

NOVEMBER 14, 1977

On November 8, 1977, a letter was received from Mr. Harry M. (Mac) Johnston, Jr., in which he conveyed a request from Senator Dennis for authority to transfer \$3,000 from a line item entitled "Secretary Research (P)" to a second account identically titled. Both of these accounts are contained in the 1977-78 Appropriation Act under The Senate and it was subsequently determined that the account from which the funds are to be transferred bears number 11064072 and the account to receive the funds bears the number 11064071.


Dear Mr. Putnam:

As you requested, this letter is in continued reference regarding Mrs. Carol C. Pendarvis of the office of Senate Research.
