

## MINUTES

### SOUTH CAROLINA BOARD OF DENTISTRY CONFERENCE CALL

On Thursday, August 7, 2003 at 1:30 p.m., Dr. Dennis Newton, Jr., President, of West Columbia, called the meeting to order. Members of the Board present were: Dr. Amon A. Martin, Jr., Vice President, of Seneca; Dr. Michelle Bedell, Secretary, of Blacksburg; Dr. Dale Finkbine, Past President, of Summerville; Dr. William Bragdon, of Greenville; Tanya Riffe, RDH, of Ravenel; and Dr. John D. Snowden of Florence.

Dr. William Cranford, Jr., of Rock Hill, and Genie Duncan, of West Columbia, were granted excused absences.

### CALL TO ORDER

Dr. Newton announced that public notice of this meeting was properly posted at the main entrances of the Kingstree Building, Synergy Business Center, and provided to all requesting persons, organizations, and news media in compliance with Section 30-4-80 of the South Carolina Freedom of Information Act. He noted that a quorum was present at all times.

Staff member present was H. Rion Alvey, Administrator. Sandra Dickert, Administrative Assistant, was also in attendance at the meeting.

### APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Dr. Bragdon moved the agenda be approved. The motion was seconded by Dr. Snowden and unanimously carried.

### DISCUSSION TOPIC

#### Approval of Reinstatement Applicants

Mr. Alvey stated that staff has received three applications for reinstatement. He further stated that Board policy, effective March 3, 2003, states that the applications cannot be approved administratively and must be approved by the Board.

#### Todd Tidwell

Dr. Tidwell was first licensed on January 26, 1998 and in practice from August 2000 to August 2002. He allowed his license to lapse in September 2002 and has not been in practice since. He has passed the exam and has paid all of the appropriate fees.

Motion: Dr. Martin made a motion, seconded by Dr. Snowden and unanimously carried, that the Board reinstate Dr. Tidwell's license.

Charles Richard Daniel, Jr.

Dr. Daniel was first issued a license in 1982. He accepted a position in Winston-Salem, North Carolina and allowed his license to expire in March 2003. He passed the exam on June 27, 2003.

Motion: Dr. Snowden made a motion, seconded by Dr. Martin and unanimously carried, that the reinstatement application be approved.

Brett Dunnill

Dr. Dunnill was issued a license on August 3, 2001 and was in practice until June 30, 2002. He then moved to Chesapeake, Virginia and placed his license on inactive status in February 2003. He is now requesting reinstatement of his license. He passed the exam on July 1, 2003. He is purchasing a practice in Charleston.

Motion: Dr. Finkbine made a motion, seconded by Dr. Bragdon and unanimously carried, to approve the reinstatement application.

#### ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business at this time, Dr. Snowden moved the meeting be adjourned. Dr. Martin seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.
