WHEREAS, women worked in every sector of the economy, from riveting airplane parts, driving streetcars, and operating heavy machinery, to collecting critical materials, working in banks and other institutions, serving on rationing boards, and much more; and

WHEREAS, these women came together to serve our great country and contribute on the home front during World War II.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the Great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim May 25, 2013, as

ROSIE THE RIVETER DAY

throughout the state and encourage all South Carolinians to honor these women for their advancement of patriotic ideas, commitment to excellence in the workplace, and loyalty to the United States of America.
