Thank you! I had to run by there this morning to get the street names correct.

On 8/9 Greenville had approximately 6 inches of rain in a very short period of time. As a result, there was some major flooding in my district as well as other areas but I know my district was hit incredibly hard. Two lives were lost and there was a lot of damage caused by the water. At the corner of Cross Creek and Eagle Crest a culvert collapsed due to the volume of water. Residents at the end of Eagle Crest received a bulk of the water and I am told had water up to 6 feet in their homes. Several of the homes have had to be completely gutted costing upwards of \$80,000.

Is there anything the state can do to assist in low interest loans for these home owners? We have a neighborhood meeting scheduled for Monday August 25th at 6:30. I would like to be able to offer some encouragement to my constituents. Several officials from Greenville County were will there as well to offer assistance. I think their biggest concerns are getting low interest loans and preventing this from happening again. What do we need to do to get FEMA assistance or help in this matter?
