Per our many discussions, a state procurement card cannot be used to procure food for the mansion because you would then be made to follow a different set of state procurement rules and regulations for anyone eating that food. There are reasons why we have this money set up on a composite account. It offers the Governor more spending freedom and you can shop at as many different stores as you would like. If you know that you are going to need additional checks all you've ever had to do is ask. The only time you are limited on this is if you are late turning in your receipts for existing outstanding checks.

I've offered to up the number of checks you are held responsible for but you made the decision not to have them. We also provide you with additional checks during times when you've been overburdened. You've stated that Emily is using your checks, so I offered to provide her with her own checks. This also was refused. I've also increased your account charging privileges with Publix.

As far as reconciling your spending from this account, that is just part of having access to write checks against the account. Its accountability.

This office is doing everything possible to help you but I cannot give you something that is going to cause more problems than it solves. I wish I could make you understand the paper work we have to process to make a purchase especially with a credit card. If you go to a credit card system to purchase food we will have no reason to have this checking account and I do not think that Gentleman Haley wants this account closed.
