The Nation's Report Card

4th Grade Reading

SC's rank (39th) is determined in a comparison of 2009 average scale scores for all students among all 50 states and the District of Columbia.

8th Grade Reading

SC's rank (42nd) is determined in a comparison of 2009 average scale scores for all students among all 50 states and the District of Columbia.

2007 ranking: (41st)

4th Grade Math

SC's rank (38th) is determined in a comparison of 2009 average scale scores for all students among all 50 states and the District of Columbia.

2007 ranking: (33rd)

8th Grade Math

SC's rank (33rd) is determined in a comparison of 2009 average scale scores for all students among all 50 states and the District of Columbia.

2007 ranking: (28th)

4th Grade Science

SC's rank (32nd) is determined in a comparison 2005 average scale scores among all 50 states. Seven states did not report scores for the 2005 4th grade science assessment.

The rate of improvement was determined in a comparison of nationwide scores on the grade 4 science assessment, given in 2000 and 2005. SC's average scale score increased 8 points from 2000 to 2005, the largest increase nationwide. Fifteen states either did not report results for the grade 4 science assessment in 2000 or 2005, so the rate of improvement could not be calculated for those states.

8th Grade Science

SC's rank (29th) is determined in a comparison 2005 average scale scores among all 50 states. Seven states did not report scores for the 2005 8th grade science assessment.

The rate of improvement was determined in a comparison of nationwide scores on the grade 8 science assessment, given in 2000 and 2005. SC's average scale score increased 5 points from 2000 to 2005, the third largest increase in the nation. Fifteen states either did not report results for the grade 8 science assessment in 2000 or 2005, so the rate of improvement could not be calculated for those states.

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On-time graduation rate

73.7% as calculated by the SCDE and reported in SC 2009 AYP release. Data retrieved from SCDE website, 11/17/2010.

A comparison was made with 22 other states currently using and reporting National Governors' Association Compact Rate. Of the 22 states that reported a graduation rate for the class of 2008-09, SC's reported rate of 73.7% ranks 14th of the 22 states.

SAT

SC's rank (48th) is determined in a comparison of 2010 average composite scores (critical reading plus math sections) among all 50 states and the District of Columbia.

ACT

SC's rank (43rd) is determined in a comparison of 2010 average composite scores among all 50 states and the District of Columbia.

2009 ranking: (46th)

Advanced Placement – Participation

SC's rank (20th) was determined in a comparison of the percent of students who took an AP exam in high school, as reported by the College Board. The College Board uses the projected number of 2009 graduates from public schools in each state as the denominator, as issued by the *Knocking at the College Door* (2003) report, Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education. SC data was compared to all 50 states and the District of Columbia. In 2009, 26 percent of students in SC took an AP exam in high school.

2008 ranking: (22nd)

Advanced Placement – Passage

SC's rank (21st) was determined in a comparison of the percent of students in the graduating class of 2009 who scored a 3 or higher on an AP exam at any point during their classroom years. In 2009, 15 percent of students in SC scored a 3 or higher on an AP exam.

Achievement Gap – AP Performance

Performance data measures the percentage point gap that exists between the passage rates (score of 3 or higher) of two student groups between 2008, 2009 and 2010. AP data reported by the College Board.
