African-American family cemetery dating from 19th or early 20th century. Overgrown with vegetation. Located within a copse of trees with a surrounding ditch visible with LiDAR. Boundary as indicated by LiDAR is approximately 60 by 60 meters. One grave marker located, belonging to Dearana/Daughter of Judge Albert with no legible date. Marker is a simple, flat, round top headstone with relief carving of a branch near the top. No other markers located.

Historical Information:

Judge Albert (father of Dearana) identified in 1900 Federal Census as 37-year-old African American farmer who rented the property he farmed. Born 1862, married to Adalaide with four living children in 1900 (Lilly, Hony, Nellie, and unnamed infant). Judge Albert and family listed in 1910 and 1920 censuses; Judge no longer listed in 1930 census. No mention of Dearana in any census.
