Commissioner's Column

**ANRCE Public Awareness Campaign---
"Pass it on Down"**

The acronym of the group, Agriculture and Natural Resources Communicators for the Environment, is ANRCE. But, the concerted effort behind the name is anything but anarchy.

In fact, this is the first time that a large contingency of agriculture and natural resources public and private organizations in South Carolina have joined forces in a concerted effort of this magnitude. And, together they have created a public awareness campaign called "Pass it on Down: SC's Special Places," using existing expertise and resources. ANRCE's goal is to bring to light areas of interest and concern for SC while highlighting Agriculture and Natural Resources Week, April 20th through the 27th.

The organizations in ANRCE include: Clemson University, SC Department of Agriculture, SC Department of Natural Resources (DNR), SC Department of Health & Environmental Control (DHEC), SC Forestry Commission, SC Farm Bureau Federation, USDA Farm Service Agency-SC, USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service-SC, USDA Rural Development-SC, and National Agricultural Statistics Service-SC.

Topics for the Agriculture and Natural Resources Awareness campaign include: the loss of wildlife and habitat protection, responsible pesticide use and monitoring, production management practices, biotech research, the farmer's role in environmental preservation, the quality of life improvements for rural residents, increased awareness of invasive species and water quality protection.

On April 20th, which is also Earth Day, an hour long "Pass It On Down" program will air at 9 P.M. on SCETV detailing efforts underway to preserve, conserve and protect South Carolina's agricultural and natural resources. In addition to the televised broadcast, Clemson University is hosting a series of programs on educational radio's "Your Day." Representatives from various agencies and organizations will talk about ways government and private industry are working cooperatively to protect the environment. The show is being aired this week on Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday, April 16th, 17th, and 19th, and next week Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday, April 23rd, 24th, and 25th during the 12 Noon hour program.

Also, several weekly and daily newspapers across the state are including features about the state's agricultural and natural resources. Depending on advertising support, the newspapers have set aside sections ranging from feature articles to full 8-page inserts. The ten agencies and organizations involved in the effort have contributed articles and photographs showing what South Carolinians can do and are doing to protect the environment.

One objective of the group is to encourage homeowners to learn how to apply in their own backyards the management practices that farmers, foresters, and other landowners use. By applying their conservation measures, average citizens can be more environmentally conscious. Like farmers, citizens of SC can use alternatives to pesticides and insecticides like scouting for insects and applying chemicals around the home only when necessary. Through SC's Boll Weevil Eradication Program, a cotton field is sprayed for boll weevils only if an insect is found in the green pheromone traps located around the field. This system protects the environment by alleviating the need to spray every field while decreasing expenses for farmers. Homeowners should also take soil samples and follow label instructions on pesticides and fertilizers. Other environmentally friendly practices include recycling residue by composting, balancing plant moisture needs with rainfall by selecting plants and grasses that don't need a lot of water, or watering lawns infrequently but deeply.

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**South Carolinians Sought For National
Peanut Board Service**

The South Carolina Peanut Board will conduct nominations for a board member and alternate position for the National Peanut Board, Tuesday, April 24, 2001 at the Ramage Conference Center located at the Columbia Farmers Market on Bluff Road. The meeting will begin at 10 am.

The NPB was established by producer referendum on July 30, 1999 and was developed to finance a coordinated program of generic promotion, information, and related research designed to maintain and expand markets for peanuts via a 1% national assessment on all peanuts produced and marketed in the U.S. The Board is composed of one producer member and one alternate member from each of the nine primary peanut-producing states. The minor peanut-producing states are represented by one at-large producer member and one at-large alternate member.

The NPB encourages eligible women, minorities, and persons with disabilities who qualify as peanut producers to attend the April 24 meeting and run for nomination.

Two nominees for the Board member seat and two nominees for the alternate member seat will be submitted to USDA Secretary Ann Veneman for appointment to a two-year term, effective January 1, 2002.

As the state's certified peanut producer organization, the South Carolina Peanut Board is charged by USDA to conduct the nominating meeting and submit the nominees names to USDA for consideration. The board urges all peanut producers from across the state to participate in the nomination process.

This is an important part of the marketing program of the South Carolina Department of Agriculture each year and support from the production community is encouraged at this event. dyed Easter chicks go?**

People have traditionally associated spring and the Easter seasons with chicks, ducklings and bunnies. Not many years ago, thousands of baby chicks were sold the week before Easter in variety stores and feed stores.

In recent years, this practice has changed. Laws have been passed that prohibit the dyeing or sale of individual chicks. The laws of South Carolina are very specific: no sales of chicks in lots of less than 25 and no dyeing of baby chicks.

In addition to following farm management practices, many programs are in progress throughout the state to protect the environment. The USDA Farm Service Agency's Conservation Reserve Program (CRP), one of the federal government's largest environmental improvement programs, retires environmentally sensitive row crop land and marginal pastureland from production. The acreage that is retired is then changed over to permanent covers. As of October 1, 2000, South Carolina had over 200,000 acres devoted to this program.

Other programs include: Clemson University's Farm-A-Syst, Coast-A-Syst, pesticide container recycling, and school pesticide inspection programs; USDA Rural Development's sewer facilities program in which funding is provided to rural communities to help balance development with environmental needs; and DHEC's waste minimization program which creates and finds suitable reuses for waste. Also, DNR works with conservation districts within each county to prevent urban erosion and control sediment and storm water, and the SC Forestry Commission provides vital information through its Best Management Practices for Forestry.

These are just a few of the many programs and projects at work in South Carolina designed to protect our agricultural and natural resources. ANRCE is focusing on these success stories in their public awareness campaign. I commend the communicators and other representatives of these agencies and organizations throughout the state for attempting to make SC residents more environmentally aware of their surroundings, so that each of us---farmer and non-farmer---can "Pass it on Down" to future generations.

These laws were passed to prevent the flood of chicks and ducklings going to animal shelters a few weeks after Easter Sunday.

At that point in their development, the chicks began to get new, usually white feathers, lost their 'toy' appeal and were discarded. Any coloring of the down of baby chicks is temporary. New feathers appeared within weeks.

Another intent of the legislation was to get away from the idea that chicks, bunnies or ducklings are playthings or toys. Many of these young animals suffered from physical trauma as young children played with them, not realizing that they were much more fragile than the plastic and metal toys they were used to handling.

Also, most households are not set up to provide the correct environment for baby chicks. It is important that chicks are kept warm, free of drafts and that they are provided with a complete diet and ready access to clean water.

So, the best way to celebrate spring 2002 and next year's Easter season is not to buy illegal pets. Remember next spring, how about buying marshmallow baby chicks?
