The State Budget and Control Board met in the office of the State Auditor at 10:00 A. M., on November 30, 1950. All members of the Board were present.

The State Auditor had prepared a tentative budget, embodying the policies outlined by the Board at its last meeting, for the operation of the State Government during the year 1951-52. A tentative estimate of revenue for that year was also presented along with the proposed budget. The figures showed that new or additional revenue would be needed in the amount of \$10,193,226.29. This budget was studied by the Board members and numerous modifications were approved by the Board. It was agreed that another meeting of the Board would be held during the week beginning December 11, and that the study of the budget would be continued then on the basis of the modifications agreed upon by the Board.

The Secretary was directed to prepared for the Board a list of salaries of department heads to be studied at that meeting.

The Board then adjourned.
