Dear Caucus Members,

Attached is information about the Department of Administration bill that is on the calendar for May 14. Please find attached to this email a pdf version of the Committee report to S. 22 (currently before the body); a visual summary showing the structure created by the committee report; and a written summary detailing both the structural and policy issue contained in the committee report.

Also, for your information, I have included a link (below) that will take you to each earlier version of the bill, including the Senate passed version. Ways and Means staff said this morning they hope to have final information on cost and FTEs by the end of next week. I will forward that on to you as soon as it is available. The Committee Report is the same bill as the conference committee compromise that we agreed to with the Senate last June minus the PEBA issue that was settled in the retirement bill. As you all know, this is a Caucus agenda item, and a priority for conservatives from the Caucus to the Governor. We fought hard for this legislation last year and came within a last-minute filibuster of getting this reform over the line.

I want to be sure everyone has a chance to read this information and study the bill before the Caucus lunch on May 14.
