**From what I can tell, this is a federal question, below is the FAA description of Shaw's Airspace:**

ASO SC D Shaw AFB, SC Shaw AFB, SC (lat. 33°58'23"N., long. 80°28'22"W.) That airspace extending upward from the surface to and including 2,700 feet MSL within a 4.4-mile radius of the Shaw AFB, excluding that airspace contained within Restricted Area R-6002 when it is in use. This Class D airspace area is effective during the specific days and times established in advance by a Notice to Airmen. The effective days and times will thereafter be continuously published in the Airport/Facility Directory. AMENDMENTS 03/20/03 68 FR 2875 (Added)

There is some ability for military bases to work with local authorities on zoning under SC Code 6-19-10 et seq. and 55-9-80 allows for eminent domain to be used for airspace, but that may only apply to non-military airports.

While at the air station in Beaufort we learned that Shaw also uses a training area in GA that belongs to the Air station in Beaufort. I have not spoken to Senator McElveen about this, please let me know how you would like to proceed.
